# Avoidant Restrictive Food Intake Disorders and Paediatric Feeding Disorders

Friday, 19 May 2023, 9.00am - 4.30pm

Avoidant Restrictive Food Intake Disorder (ARFID) and Paediatric Feeding Disorder (PFD) are recently defined conditions that are characterised by eating difficulties resulting in malnutrition & growth delay, acute medical problems, psychological distress & reduced wellbeing for the young person, as well as having significant impact on the broader family system.

Awareness of ARFID and PFD and the significant impact of these eating disorders is limited amongst health professionals, with coordinated and evidence-informed service responses only beginning to emerge.
