SNPHN Needs Assessment

- Young people in the region have a high rate of body image issues inc. body dysmorphia & disordered eating
- Eating disorders & obsessive compulsive disorders account for the largest proportion of bed days in 0-17 year olds¹

COMMISSIONED SERVICE

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM





- Access to the Intensive Outpatient Program to 12 clients for 18 weeks who reside in the SNPHN region and are in need of financial assistance to access the program
- Clinical Support Officer to provide clinic coordination support, develop promotional materials and assist with service promotion
